

As part of this rule, the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is requiring all public water supply systems to identify the materials of service lines connected to the distribution system. Iowa Lakes Regional Water is requesting your assistance by taking a short survey that will help us to compile a database of the materials used in our customers' service lines.
