WINTER DISCONNECT PROGRAM

Enjoy peace of mind knowing your seasonal property will not suffer damage due to frozen pipes this winter!

Reminder: You can disconnect and reconnect your service when it fits your schedule. As long as you provide 24 hours notice, pick the day that works best for you!

Property owners: Winterizing your dwelling is part of home maintenance. Once a water service has been disconnected, a professional plumber should clear any remaining water from the service line to prevent frozen pipes.

Rates: Regularly scheduled appointments are \$40.00 (cost includes both spring and winter connections). As an added convenience, emergency appointments can also be scheduled any time, any day! Appointments scheduled without 24 hours notice are \$75.00 and after-hours/weekend appointments are \$150.00.
