IT'S THAT TIME OF THE YEAR! 2022 Water Treatment Maintenance

Every year, ILRW performs extensive maintenance on the water softening equipment at the Clay treatment plant to maintain the quality you enjoy. The work will begin the week of March 14th and last approximately one week.

Typical softness for your rural water is 7-10 grains per gallon. During maintenance, you may experience harder water for a brief period. This will likely temporarily increase residue on items around the house, such as dishes, showers, and plumbing fixtures. Regardless of these noticeable changes, the water will continue to be safe to drink.

RATE ANNOUNCEMENT

ON JANUARY 20, 2022 THE BOARD APPROVED THE UPCOMING FISCAL YEAR WATER BUDGET AND RATE STRUCTURE EFFECTIVE APRIL 1, 2022. DUE TO THE CONTINUED PRICE INCREASE IN CHEMICALS AND PURCHASED WATER, A MINIMAL RATE INCREASE FOR THE FIRST 3,000 GALLONS WILL PROVIDE THE RESOURCES TO MAKE THE NECESSARY REPAIRS AND IMPROVEMENTS TO ALL COMPONENTS OF THE WATER SYSTEM.

WE ARE HAPPY TO ANNOUNCE ONCE AGAIN, THERE WILL BE NO INCREASE TO THE MONTHLY MINIMUM WATER RATE THIS YEAR!
